## Ruth's Story. Your Story.

### Ruth Devotions / Week 2 "Faithfulness"

#### Day 1:

Scripture / Read Deuteronomy 7:9; Psalm 33:4

How do these passages speak to your heart today?

In our world today, we often hear of so many promises being broken that sometimes it's hard to trust people...maybe even people close to us.

When is the last time you were lied to? Who is someone you know that always keeps their promises? What about you...how well do you follow through on your promises to others?

Think about how good God is...how Faithful God is...that He keeps His covenant and His promises generation after generation after generation.

As you pray, Thank God for being so faithful to you!

...Today, Reflect on the ways you experience God's Faithfulness in situations you may face during your day

#### Day 2:

Scripture / Read I John 1:5-10

Re-read this passage and ask God to help you fully grasp it's meaning for your life today.

When have you not forgiven someone in your life...when have you asked someone to forgive you and they wouldn't. How do you feel about both situations if you experienced them?

Read v.9 again and think about how good God is that He is always Faithful in forgiving our sins when we confess them to Him.

...Today, as you pray, really think of the sins in your life and ask God to help you repent of them and give you forgiveness for them. Also, think of what Christ did so that you can be forgiven.



#### Day 3:

Scripture / Read Hebrews 11:1-12:3

This passage is often called the "Roll Call of Faith". Which stories in this passage are your favorite Bible stories or characters? Why?

How does their faith in God and His faithfulness to them encourage you? What lessons can their lives teach you?

How can you live a life of incredible faith in God? What will the story of your life be for those who come after you and hear of your life?

...Today, Pray and ask God to give you the opportunity to really reveal your faith in Him to others or to do something that requires great Faith in Him to accomplish it.

#### Day 4:

Scripture / Read Proverbs 3:5-10

What is this passage speaking to you?

You've probably heard this scripture often, but think about it with an open heart and mind and let it be fresh to you today.

How can you really Trust in the Lord and Commit everything in your life to Him? What do you need to do to accomplish this?

Re-read v. 8 and think about the connection between v.5-8.

...Today, as you do through your day, think of committing all you do to the Lord. Trust in God's Faithfulness as you are Faithful to Him.

#### Day 5:

Scripture / Read Exodus 16:1-35; John 6:31-34

How dependent do you really believe you are for everything in your life?

Think of how the Israelites really depended upon God for everything, and God was always faithful...even in providing the food they needed daily.

Read V.22. The Lord was faithful in providing for them each day, and on the 6<sup>th</sup> day they gathered 2 days worth so they could have the Sabbath to Rest and Worship the Lord. Think of God's Faithfulness in always providing for them when they were faithful to Him.

When is the last time you really acknowledged your dependence on God?

Think of the ways the Lord has always provided for your life, even when you didn't ask or see the need.

...Today, reflect often on all that the Lord blesses your life with and provides for you because of His faithfulness!
