Ruth Devotions / Week 3 "Providence"

Day 1:

Scripture / Read Exodus 1:22 – 2:10

Think of how God placed his future leader to lead the Israelites out of Egypt right where He wanted him even as a baby. Instead of being killed, God led Moses' life to be placed in a position where God would use Him. See where God has placed you and ask Him to help you see why He has placed you where you are. Ask Him to help you be a leader for Him and for others right where you are currently.

Day 2:

Scripture / Read I Chronicles 29:11

Reflect on what this verse is speaking to you as God leads you in this devotion. How do you understand the last part and really knowing that we are part of God's Kingdom, but He is head over it? If everything in heaven and on earth is God's, how does that impact your thoughts on your life? Ask God to help you live in light that He is truly Lord over all and Lord over your life!

Day 3:

Scripture / Read Genesis 50:19-21

Reflect over Joseph's life and all the ups and downs he endured. Yet, in the end, he saw God leading in all parts and facets to put him in the position to save many lives. Ask God to help you think over all the events of your life...good and difficult ones...and see how God led you to the point where you are at today. Thank God for all He has brought you through and putting you where you are today.

Day 4:

Scripture / Read Isaiah 64:8

What is this passage speaking to you?

Think of a potter's wheel and how the Potter continues to mold and shape the piece of clay to get it "just right". What areas of your life do you see God molding and shaping right now? What areas do you wish He would focus on? Take some time and think of God as the Potter of your life as you are the clay. Ask Him to help you see if there are areas that you are being resistant that He wants to mold and shape...if so, Surrender those areas to Him, and let Him mold and shape away according to His plans.

Day 5:

Scripture / Read Romans 11:33-36

Think for a moment on the first part of verse 33. Obviously, we can never understand God's Wisdom or knowledge, but let that bring you hope in the Big God that we serve.

In looking at verse 36, how does this help you know How God is in control of our lives?

Re-read this passage and let God speak to you through it in trusting Him as He leads your life..
